

Kettleson Library Commission  
Work Session  
January 19, 2008  
9:00-11:30 a.m.

Curt Ledford, Commission President, convened the group with an overview of why the Board had determined to have a session devoted to reaffirming the direction and goals of the group.

A brainstorming session ensued with each member in turn expressing their thoughts on goals the library board might address. This very productive interchange concluded with the formation of the following three goals:

**The Kettleson Library Commission will attempt to revitalize the Friends of the Library service organization.**

- Existing Friends as identified by the membership list, as well as potential members solicited through the media and personal contact will be invited to a brunch at the Library on March 1 at 10:00 a.m.
- The Board with the assistance of the Library Director will create a list of possible Friend projects that would offer support to the Library.

**The Kettleson Library Commission will create regular forms of communication with City staff and Assembly members.**

- Board members will contemplate how this should be done and be ready for further discussion at the next meeting.
- Curt will contact the City Administrator for clarification of refurbishment of the library as referenced on the City Capital Improvement list sent to the State.

**The Kettleson Library Commission will continue to promote literacy in the community.**

- The Library Director will be sure commission members are kept informed of all literary events that take place at the library,

In further discussion, Cheryl gave an update on the status of Stratton Library and the Andrews Collection.

The Board briefly discussed future library expansion. Cheryl gave her opinion that the old expansion plans are no longer adequate and there needs to be a new start with input from staff, community and the Board.
