

To avoid contamination in recycling stream, please follow these basic rules...

#1 PLASTIC BOTTLES - All colors accepted. Rinsed, caps removed. Labels OK.

#2 COLORED PLASTIC - Rinsed, caps removed. Check for #2 Recycle symbol.

#2 PLASTIC MILK JUGS - "Cloudy" milk jugs accepted. Rinsed, caps removed, flattened, and placed in proper bin at Recycling Center.

**UNSURE ABOUT PLASTIC NUMBER?
TOSS IT OUT!**

ALUMINUM - Scrap aluminum and cans are accepted at the recycling center. Please dispose of plastic bags and other non-aluminum items in garbage bin.

BATTERIES (Dry Cell) - Can be recycled at the local grocery stores, True Value, Spenards', City Hall, and Harry Race.

CAR & MARINE BATTERIES - Can be taken to NAPA (747-6659) or Carquest Auto Parts (747-3238).

CARDBOARD - Corrugated cardboard ONLY. Flatten and remove staples. NO waxed boxes accepted (fish or vegetable boxes).

GLASS - Rinsed, caps removed (metal or plastic). Paper labels OK.

METAL CANS - Cleaned, paper labels removed. NO aluminum (soda or beer cans).

MIXED PAPER - All business/office paper, catalogs, magazines, cereal boxes, etc. Staples are ok, but please, NO paper-clips.

NEWSPAPER - Newspaper print ONLY. News paper inserts are OK.

SHREDDED PAPER - Secure scraps in plastic/paper bag. Please DO NOT place loose shredded paper in bin

Please Take Note...

Mixed Paper & Cardboard can be recycled at Keet Gooshi Heen Elementary School during the school year.

Plastic grocery bags can be returned to the grocery store.

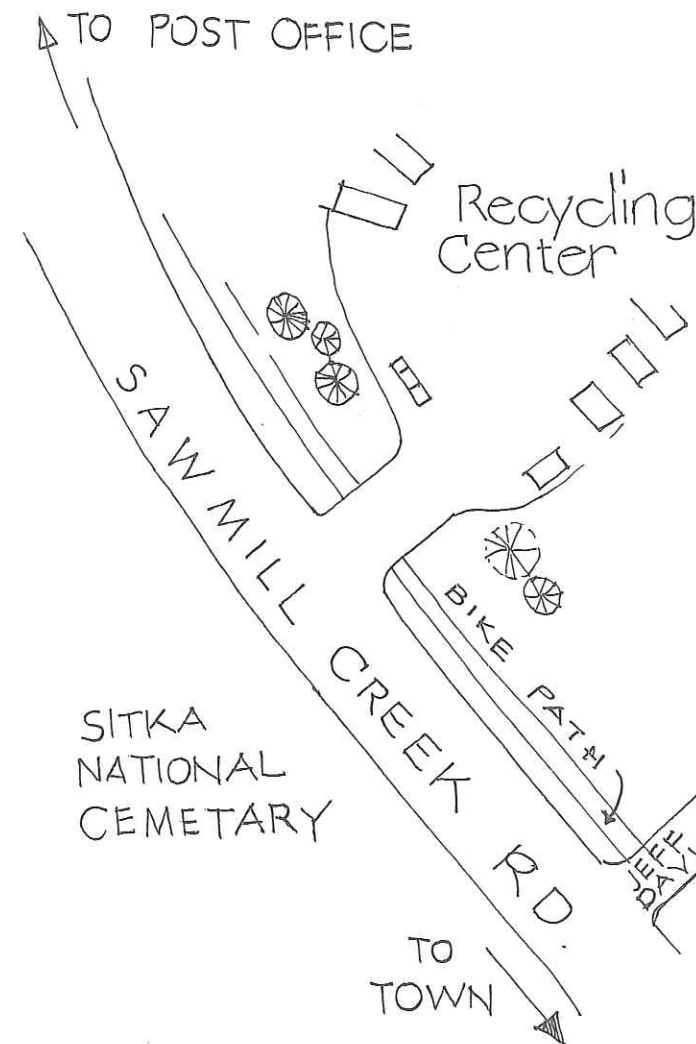
Glass recycling can be found at the Municipal Recycling Center, Sealing Cove, and the Main Post Office.

Used Oil: Each harbor in town has a green container specifically used to store used motor oil.

Fluorescent Tube/Bulb Recycling: Saturdays Only (or by special arrangement). 12-1pm. \$0.50 charge per bulb.

- Newspaper
- Glass
- Clean Metal Cans
- Aluminum Cans
- Cloudy Milk Jugs (#2 Plastic)
- #1 & #2 Plastics
- Bagged Shredded Paper
- Fluorescent Tubes & Bulbs (12-1pm Sat. \$0.50 fee)
