PROPOSITION NO. 1

This question is in accordance with Ordinance 00-1578, which is available for review at each polling precinct.

Shall Section 11.16 of the Charter be amended to:

- (a) define the purpose of the Sitka Permanent Fund as increasing the principal of the Permanent Fund to provide an ever-increasing income stream to the Sitka General Fund forever to reduce the tax burdens on the citizens of Sitka;
- (b) change the method of counting revenues from real property sold by the City and Borough when the City and Borough was leasing the real property immediately before the sale;
- (c) change the formula for the distribution of the income of the Sitka Permanent Fund to the Sitka General Fund; and
- (d) require that all dividends and capital gains from the Sitka Permanent Fund be reinvested into the Sitka Permanent Fund; and
- (e) require the Assembly to adopt an ordinance setting out an investment policy governing the management of the Sitka Permanent Fund?
