THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA ANNOUNCES ITS ANNUAL COMMUNITY-WIDE CLEAN-UP EVENT

WHO:

All **RESIDENTIAL** property owners are encouraged to clean up their property and haul all acceptable refuse to the City Solid Waste Disposal Sites **FREE OF CHARGE** during **CITY SPRING CLEAN-UP 2026**. **Dump trucks and dump trailers cannot be used.**

WHEN:

Saturday, April 25th to Sunday, May 3rd from 8AM to 4PM

WHERE:

- **Sitka Transfer Station, 205 Jarvis Street** – General residential refuse.
- **Sawmill Cove Industrial Park Scrap Yard, 4655 Sawmill Creek Road** – Junk vehicles, scrap metal, water tanks, refrigerators (must be cleaned of food), dryers, washing machines, stoves, aluminum boats, boat trailers, outboards, and lower units (shall be drained of oil), properly cleaned fuel tanks accepted, and unbroken residential fluorescent bulbs will be accepted.
- **Sawmill Creek Road Recycling Center, 802 Sawmill Creek Road** – All glass, tin cans, aluminum, #1, #2 and #5 plastics and corrugated brown cardboard and newspaper.
- **Granite Creek Overburden Site, 401 Granite Creek Road (follow signs)** – WEEKENDS ONLY – Up to 5 yards of residential yard waste (including brush, overburden, stumps, & green waste).
- **Sitka Landfill, Granite Creek Road** – wooden or fiberglass boats accepted by approval and appointment only by calling 747-1865. **Standard rates apply.**
- **Household Hazardous Waste Collection at the Wastewater Treatment Plant – 100 Alice Loop** Saturday, May 2 from 8 AM to 4 PM and Sunday, May 3 from 8 AM to 3 PM (last weekend only). Household Hazardous Waste will **NOT** be accepted at the Transfer Station or Sawmill Cove Industrial Park Scrap Yard. See the Household Hazardous Waste Flyer.

Vehicles: Electric vehicles accepted, only if batteries have been removed.

- Only vehicles $\frac{3}{4}$ ton rated or smaller will be accepted free of charge.
- Vehicles **MUST** be accompanied with a Title OR a notarized 849 DMV form to be accepted
- Vehicles shall be cleaned of all garbage and/or food
- Vehicles must be towed at owner's expense
- Oversized vehicles such as RVs and buses, rated 1 ton or larger, will be charged - **standard rates apply** and accepted by scheduled appointment only
- No heavy equipment will be accepted during this event

Other:

- ALL commercial waste will be charged - **standard rates apply**
- Metal boats will be accepted at the Sawmill Cove Industrial Cove Scrap Yard – **standard rates apply**

SPRING 2026 FREE HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION EVENT

May 2nd, Saturday (8:00 AM - 4:00 PM)
May 3rd, Sunday (8:00 AM - 3:00 PM)

WHERE: Deliver your items to the Wastewater Treatment Plant 100 Alice Loop, located off the Airport Road.

WHO'S ELIGIBLE: All households are eligible for the free event. Small businesses and government agencies are eligible for a fee and must be pre-arranged with HHW Event staff. Please contact the Public Works Office at 747-1804 for more information.

WHAT'S ELIGIBLE: Solvents, oils, paints, antifreeze, cleaners, poisons, acids, FLA/SLA lead acid batteries, (no lithium ion and no nickel-metal hydride batteries), caustics, furniture stripper, herbicides, pesticides, flares, printing & photographic chemicals.

WHAT'S NOT ELIGIBLE: Explosives, blasting caps and gun powder, reactives such as sodium metal and radioactive waste, and fluorescent bulbs. Lithium ion and nickel-metal hydride batteries.

Please DO NOT deliver items prior to or after the event times.

Fuel Tanks - must be drained completely and cleaned (if over 500 gal must be cut into pieces less than 5' x 12')
Fuel from Fuel Tank must be put into a separate container and can be brought out (Please call to coordinate first)

Junk Vehicles need a Title (remove the bottom and send it in to DMV) or a **Notarized** DMV Form 849 – Notice of Intent to Dismantle or Junk Vehicle. Vehicles and small trucks ¾ ton or smaller (\$0.0528/lb) Trucks/Vans larger than ¾ ton (\$0.0928/lb). Electric vehicles are accepted if their batteries are removed first.

Please deposit overburden and then sign in at the little shack. Marble Island LLC will send you an invoice. **Base rate \$4.80 / Cubic Yard (minimum charge of \$12.00).** This site is for: Brush, Overburden, Stumps, Green Waste, Yard Waste, Tree Limbs

Vehicle batteries – NAPA Sitka Motor Supply (free of charge). **They do not accept Electric Vehicle Batteries**

Sitka Landfill - Construction Debris: (By appointment only: Call 747-1865)

Asbestos - \$77.80/cubic yard (By appointment only)

Asphalt - \$17.18/cubic yard

Boats - Dependent on size (Please call 747-1865 for more information and appointment)

Concrete - \$17.18/cubic yard

Construction Debris - \$0.1679/lb (must be approved by Public Works Director and by appointment only)

Granite Creek Overburden Waste Disposal Site Transition

The current public overburden waste disposal site within the Granite Creek Industrial Area (401 Granite Creek Road, north side of road) will be closing to all users after Tuesday, August 31, 2021, and will not accept any large loads (larger than a pickup truck) after Saturday, August 21, 2021.

A new public overburden waste disposal site within the Granite Creek Industrial Area (south side of Granite Creek Road) will officially open Wednesday, September 1, 2021. The new site will be operated by Marble Island, LLC. See attached map for location. Signs will be posted on Granite Creek Road guiding users to the new site and instructions to users will be displayed at the check-in “shack” at the new site.

After August 21, large users will need to coordinate with Marble Island, LLC to use the new site in advance of its official opening on September 1.
