G. COMMUNICATIONS

- Amateur Radio Emergency Services (ARES) Report: SHARK member Darryl Ault gave report as the President of the SHARK club. He discussed the background that the group was founded in 2017 with 3 members and now has 37. They are not CB radios and require FCC licensing. The goal of the organization is a communications trailer that can be utilized during emergencies. The group have all the equipment for it but are currently fundraising for the trailer. They predict it will cost 8 to 10 thousand dollars and are currently about half way there. More information can be found on their Facebook page. Chief Warren talked about how valuable these resources were during hurricane Katrina.
- Broadcast Communications Update Becky Meiers discussed the public safety announcements and that they are looking for more input from the LEPC. KCAW have also received a donation from the Murdoch Charitable Trust for new wind and solar energy at their transmitter sites which will allow as much power at these transmitters as the FCC allows.
