<u>Reports</u>

Jessica Ieremia (Library Director) -

- Visitor numbers continue to increase, we are at or above pre-pandemic numbers
- Wi-Fi statistics are also kept (by the state) and will be reported on in the future
- Looking at a data port being installed above the doorway for better recording
- LED monitors to display all Library programs and activities will be installed at the circulation desk and in the Teen Room
- Shelving installation is complete; working on DVD signage; still trying to schedule Sitka Electric for repairs
- Library Zones are being defined; 2 new tables coming and additional new furniture will be ordered with a \$35,000 donation from the Friends
- Multipurpose Room reservation system for public programs is coming
- IT is working on installing 2 new public machines; monthly updates of machines is happening; but no monthly meetings
- White Elephant grant of \$1,500 was awarded for games and puzzles
- Chess Tournament is scheduled for May
- AKLA 2026 Conference would be in March and staff, Commissioners, and Friends would be needed to help organize and put on the statewide event if we agree to host, Jess will send us links for previous conferences
- 100th Birthday Party door count was 1,825 people!

Friends Liaison (Jeff Budd) - A guided Library walk of the 13 different locations of the Sitka library over the last 100 years will be held on April 8th; Pub Quiz will be moderated by Crystal and held on April 20th; Louise Brightman tea is scheduled for April 30th.
