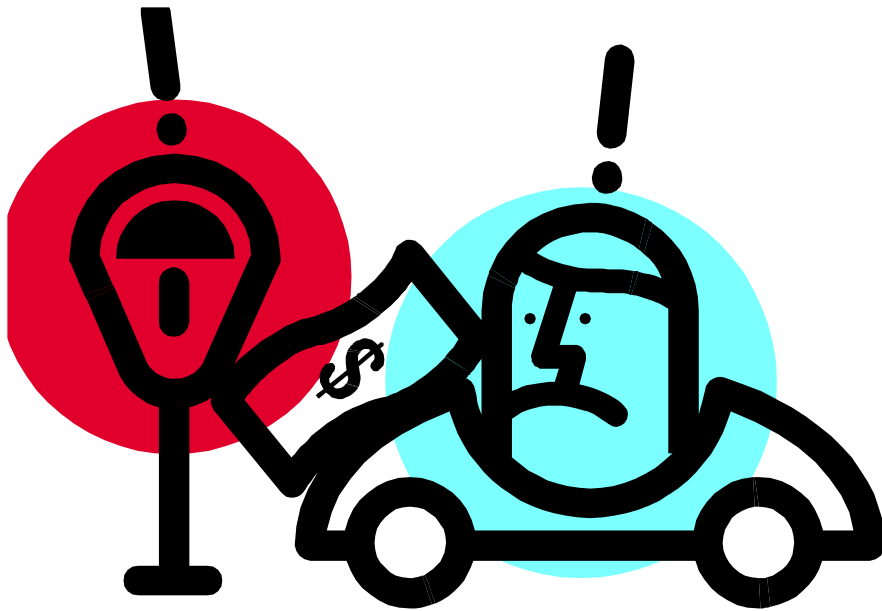

11.28.010 Traffic code—Adoption of state traffic laws.

City and borough of Sitka adopts all state traffic statutes and regulations of the state of Alaska, as they presently exist and as they may be revised in the future as the traffic code for the city and borough of Sitka. (Ord. [21-43](#) § 4, 2021; Ord. [15-20](#) § 4 (part), 2015; Ord. [13-40](#) § 4 (part), 2013.)

11.28.020 Adoption of state penalties.

City and borough of Sitka adopts as its traffic fine schedule the “Traffic Bail Forfeiture Schedule” and the “Oversize Vehicle Bail Forfeiture Schedule” in Administrative Rules 43.1 and 43.6 of the Alaska Rules of Court and any other bail forfeiture schedules relating to vehicles adopted by the Alaska Supreme Court. In addition, city and borough adopts all amendments of those schedules that become effective after the effective date of the ordinance codified in this chapter. Citations for offenses listed on these schedules may be disposed of as provided in AS [12.25.195](#) through [12.25.230](#), without a court appearance, upon payment of the amounts listed plus the state surcharge required by AS [12.55.039](#) and [29.25.074](#). If a person charged with one of these offenses appears in court and is found guilty, the penalty imposed for the offense may not exceed the amount listed for that offense on the schedule. Citations charging these offenses must meet the requirements of Minor Offense Rule 3 of the Alaska Rules of Court. If an offense is not listed on the fine schedule, the defendant must appear in court to answer to the charges. (Ord. [21-43](#) § 4, 2021; Ord. [13-40](#) § 4 (part), 2013.)

11.28.030 Violation—Infraction.

A violation of the traffic code of the city and borough of Sitka is an infraction within the terms of AS [28.90.010](#) and is punishable by a fine not to exceed three hundred dollars. (Ord. [21-43](#) § 4, 2021; Ord. [13-40](#) § 4 (part), 2013.)

13 Alaska Admin. Code § 02.340

Section 13 AAC 02.340 - Stopping, standing, or parking on highway and in other locations

(2) stand or park a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except momentarily to pick up or discharge a passenger or passengers

(A) in front of a public or private driveway;

(B) on private property without the consent of the owner or person in control of the property;

(C) in an alley in a business district where no parking spaces are provided, except for the expeditious loading or unloading of freight, materials or passengers, or in a manner or under conditions which leaves less than 10 feet of the width of the alley for the movement of vehicular traffic, or in a position which blocks the driveway entrance to abutting property;

(D) within 15 feet of a fire hydrant;

(E) within 20 feet of a crosswalk at an intersection;

(F) within 30 feet on the approach side of a flashing signal, stop sign, yield sign, or traffic-control signal located at the side of a roadway;

(G) within 20 feet of the driveway entrance to a fire station or within the area directly across the street from the entrance to a fire station, if the distance from the driveway entrance of the station to the opposite side of the street or roadway or opposite curb is less than 75 feet; or

(H) at a place where an official traffic-control device prohibits standing;

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-XX

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF SITKA AMENDING TITLE 11 "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" OF THE SITKA GENERAL CODE BY UPDATING CHAPTER 11.75 "ALL-PURPOSE VEHICLES"

1. CLASSIFICATION. This ordinance is of a permanent nature and is intended to become a part of the Sitka General Code.

2. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance or any application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and application to any person or circumstance shall not be affected.

3. PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to update the APV code (SGC 11.75.040) by permitting passengers on ATVs equipped with two seats by the manufacturer and by expanding the exceptions to the APV hours of operation prohibition by (1) including travel to and from the airport or ferry terminal for departures and arrivals, and (2) when snow plowing.

4. ENACTMENT. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the City and Borough of Sitka that the Sitka General Code Title 11, entitled "Vehicles and Traffic", Chapter 11.75, entitled "All Purpose Vehicles", at Section 11.75.040, entitled "Operations of APVs on public roadways within the city and borough", be amended to read as follows (deleted language stricken, new language underlined):

VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

11.75 All Purpose Vehicles

Chapter 11.75
ALL-PURPOSE VEHICLES

Sections:

11.75.040 Operations of APVs on public roadways within the city and borough.

- 50 F. Traffic Laws. The operator of an APV must observe all state and municipal laws which

- 90 G. Hours of Operation. Operation of an APV is prohibited on a public roadway within the
91 city and borough from twelve a.m. to five a.m. of every day of the week, except when
92 circumstances exist which justify an exception because operation of the APV was necessary or
93 unavoidable. Exceptions are limited to nonrecreational use and may only be allowed when
94 involved in an emergency or going to or returning from employment, without detour or stop, or
95 engaged in an employment activity, without detour or stop, or when traveling to and from the
96 airport or ferry terminal for departures and arrivals, without detour or stop, or when snow
97 plowing. There is no seasonal limitation on operation of APVs on public roadways within the
98 city and borough.
