City and borough of Sitka adopts all state traffic statutes and regulations of the state of Alaska, as they presently exist and as they may be revised in the future as the traffic code for the city and borough of Sitka. (Ord. <u>21-43</u> § 4, 2021; Ord. <u>15-20</u> § 4 (part), 2015: Ord. <u>13-40</u> § 4 (part), 2013.)

11.28.020 Adoption of state penalties.

City and borough of Sitka adopts as its traffic fine schedule the "Traffic Bail Forfeiture Schedule" and the "Oversize Vehicle Bail Forfeiture Schedule" in Administrative Rules 43.1 and 43.6 of the Alaska Rules of Court and any other bail forfeiture schedules relating to vehicles adopted by the Alaska Supreme Court. In addition, city and borough adopts all amendments of those schedules that become effective after the effective date of the ordinance codified in this chapter. Citations for offenses listed on these schedules may be disposed of as provided in AS 12.25.195 through 12.25.230, without a court appearance, upon payment of the amounts listed plus the state surcharge required by AS 12.55.039 and 29.25.074. If a person charged with one of these offenses appears in court and is found guilty, the penalty imposed for the offense may not exceed the amount listed for that offense on the schedule. Citations charging these offenses must meet the requirements of Minor Offense Rule 3 of the Alaska Rules of Court. If an offense is not listed on the fine schedule, the defendant must appear in court to answer to the charges. (Ord. 21-43 § 4, 2021; Ord. 13-40 § 4 (part), 2013.)

11.28.030 Violation—Infraction.

A violation of the traffic code of the city and borough of Sitka is an infraction within the terms of AS <u>28.90.010</u> and is punishable by a fine not to exceed three hundred dollars. (Ord. <u>21-43</u> § 4, 2021; Ord. <u>13-40</u> § 4 (part), 2013.)

- (2) stand or park a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except momentarily to pick up or discharge a passenger or passengers

- (C) in an alley in a business district where no parking spaces are provided, except for the expeditious loading or unloading of freight, materials or passengers, or in a manner or under conditions which leaves less than 10 feet of the width of the alley for the movement of vehicular traffic, or in a position which blocks the driveway entrance to abutting property;

(D) within 15 feet of a fire hydrant;

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- F. Traffic Laws. The operator of an APV must observe all state and municipal laws which pertain to the operation of vehicles upon a public roadway. When driving on a public roadway within the city and borough, APVs:
- Must stay on the correct side of the lane of traffic except when crossing the public roadway;
 - 2. Must travel in single file, not abreast of other moving vehicles or APVs;
 - 3. May not pass other moving vehicles or APVs:
 - May not weave in and out of traffic;
- 5. May not operate in any other manner that may be considered careless, reckless or negligent;
- May not allow passengers, except for UTVs equipped with seatbelts and ATVs equipped with two seats by the manufacturer;
- 7. Must not exceed the weight limit as established by the manufacturer (including cargo) and must be of a weight that the operator is able to control the movement of and to stop and hold it under normal conditions of operations;
 - 8. May not exceed the posted speed limit;
 - Must be equipped with an engine of two hundred fifty cc or more;
- Must be able to travel at the posted speed limit of the public roadway it travels 10. upon;
 - 11. Must be able to travel under two-wheel drive;
 - 12. Must comply with noise and smoke rules as provided in Section 11.44.020;
- 13. Must comply with rules related to obstruction to a driver's view as provided in Section 11.44.030;
 - Must not travel on public roadways while towing a trailer, sled, toboggan or other 14. object.
- Hours of Operation. Operation of an APV is prohibited on a public roadway within the city and borough from twelve a.m. to five a.m. of every day of the week, except when circumstances exist which justify an exception because operation of the APV was necessary or unavoidable. Exceptions are limited to nonrecreational use and may only be allowed when involved in an emergency or going to or returning from employment, without detour or stop, or engaged in an employment activity, without detour or stop, or when traveling to and from the airport or ferry terminal for departures and arrivals, without detour or stop, or when snow plowing. There is no seasonal limitation on operation of APVs on public roadways within the city and borough.
