He is planning the prep work. We are planning to just cut the trees and use a chipper. The soil will be mounded so we don't have to worry about the tree stumps. They have been building soil to use for this project. They will also add boulders.

We discussed the seed mix they plan to use for the non-mowed areas. They are planning to prep the areas before seeding. T&L is happy to help with this project.

Kent Smith shared his background with us, including working for a commercial landscape company. He's been with the local ground maintenance crew since 2022.
