# About Bear Paw Charters LLC and vessel MY Bear Paw

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Bear Paw Charters LLC is owned by William (Bill) West. Chrystal Rozander is organizer for the LLC and also Bill's wife.

Home port is Sitka, AK and anticipate the bulk of our charters to depart and drop in Sitka unless otherwise arranged. Bear Paw is 90' in length, steel built with aluminum superstructure and is a 12 passenger vessel with a crew of 3, minimum 2.

MY Bear Paw boasts a 2 man elevator on board to serve all three decks. This unique equipment will allow guests whom may have limited mobilities, to join us on a once in a lifetime experience in the heart of SE Alaska. Each guest stateroom is king sized and is wheelchair accessible throughout the stateroom with exception of the showers and doorways not quite qualifying as ADA compliant to be considered "handicapped accessible." Please view the vessel as more appropriate for guests with limited mobilities. There are cranes and ramps to offer additional support, ship to shore.



# Operating Plan

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Typical charters expect to be 6-7 night trips up to 6 guests. We anticipate an average of 5 guests. Season for 2023 will begin June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025 and end Sept 15, 2025 to reposition vessel south for winter moorage.

We will pick/drop guests via tender or at dock in Sitka harbor and guests are to arrange their own way there for pick up. We are not shuttling guests or involving ourselves with their lodging prior, or after they disembark Bear Paw. Charters starts at noon and ends at noon on the charter dates. Safety briefing upon arriving on board Bear Paw. Crew will consist of a minimum of two named operators whom possess a USGC Marine Merchant license. A third crew member will be an employee and license is not required but useful if they do so they can operate the tender for transporting guests.

## Anticipated number of charters per month for the season.

June – We anticipate 2 x 6 night charters per month with proposed use of Goddard Hot Springs and Baronof Warm Springs, to occur once per charter at each location for 2 hours per visit.

July – Aug - We anticipate 3x 7 night charters per month with proposed use of Goddard Hot Springs and Baronof Warm Springs, to occur once per charter at each location for 2 hours per visit.

Sept – We anticipate 1 x 7 night charter with proposed use of Baronof Warm Springs, to occur once per charter at each location for 2 hours per visit.

We anticipate some day charters, we think there might be a 2-6 of these over the course of our season.  
Goddard Hot Springs only – 2 hours of use





# Operation Plan Continued

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## Main Activities:

Eco-tour by boat, vessel's tender & water toys like paddle board and kayaks etc.

Nature hikes, photographing, whale watching

Salt & Fresh water fishing at times



Regarding collection and payments:

We do use brokers and travel agents, average commission is 10-15% of gross, and direct bookings

We collect all payments directly and at times we use a clearing house for holding funds when a broker is used. (Charter Yacht Solutions)



A 18' tender will provide transport for our guests from ship to shore.

Guests may also access shore via kayak or paddleboard





# Requested Areas of Use

## Baranof Warm Springs

We request permit to allow guests to enjoy the hot springs and walk the boardwalk.

Shall leave no trace

Garbage remains on Bear Paw and will be hauled back to the boat.

Restroom use is only at the restroom which is provided at the public bathhouse, otherwise primarily on Bear Paw where we hold our sewage.





# Requested Areas of Use

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## Goddard Hot Springs

We request permit to allow guests to enjoy the hot springs and walk the boardwalk. We recognize that water taxi's only are approved as of now. Requesting anyways.

Will leave no trace.

All garbage to return to Bear Paw and restroom use only at outhouse provided on site. Guests prefer to use Bear Paw's facilities anyways and offered prior and after guests use the springs.
